Data source for 1305 ECE performance measures

- **Let's Move Child Care (LMCC) quiz**
- **Benefits:**
 - Reduced grantee burden
 - Free, online, brief (15 items)
 - CDC will generate ECE performance measure data annually
- **Eligibility**
 - 1305 grantees (i.e., state health departments)
 - PI's will receive sign-up documents
 - Info sheet
 - Consent forms
 - *Optional* Excel spreadsheet



- **A director of multiple facilities should provide a unique email for each facility**
- **(If applicable) Use the same email address that was used to register for LMCC/take an LMCC quiz at an earlier time**
 - Some ECEs already have an LMCC account. If so, then you won't need to re-enter their city, state, etc. The webpage will take you directly to the quiz.

How can grantees use this data for TA?

- **Aggregate TA**
 - Heat map → identify priority areas
- **Facility-level TA**
 - Ask ECEs to save or print quiz results and/or action plan
 - Ask ECEs to take the quiz in real time
 - (Optional) Request ECE-level quiz results from CDC
